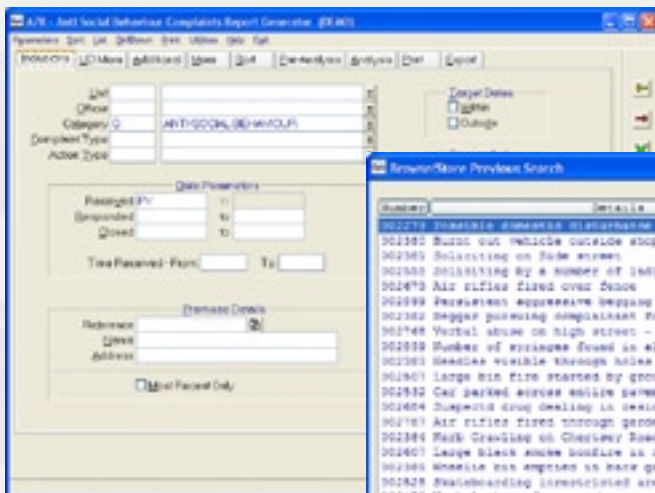
Fully Integrated MapObjects GIS Toolkit

Authority Public Protection (Formerly Flare system) have developed a fully integrated ESRI MapObjects solution. This provides the user with a new way of interfacing with Geographical Information Systems (GIS).

The new interface is XML based and considerably enhances the GIS functionality available with APP. The cost of deployment to a large number of workstations is also likely to be significantly less than with desktop versions of GIS programs.

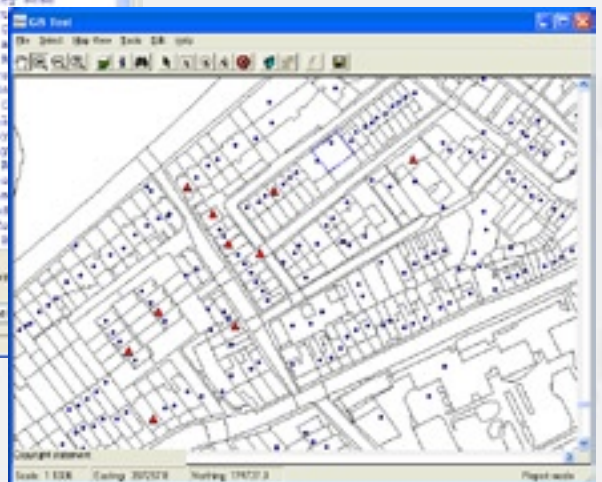
Functionality available across the system

- Plotting and saving of features on the map for premises and activities
- APP activity type and premises usage to GIS layer configuration
- Insert premises and activity records from the GIS (including import of UPRN/OSAPR, easting and northing into premises/activity record)
- Update existing APP record with easting and northing from GIS
- Find APP record from the map
- Import from GIS to personal databases
- Handles ESRI shapefiles

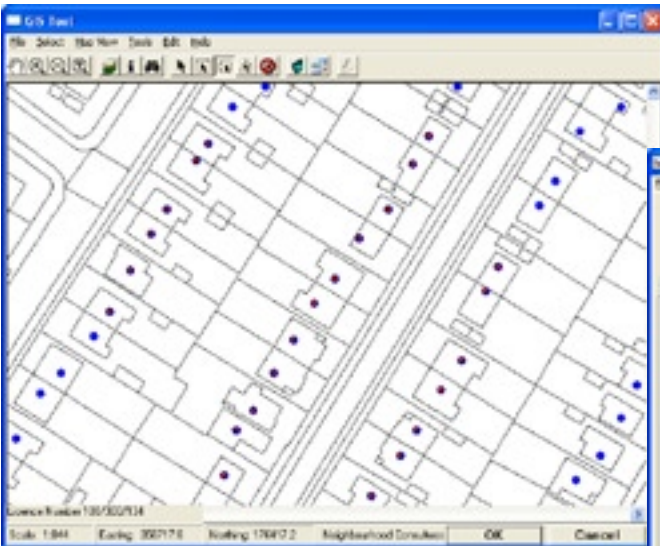

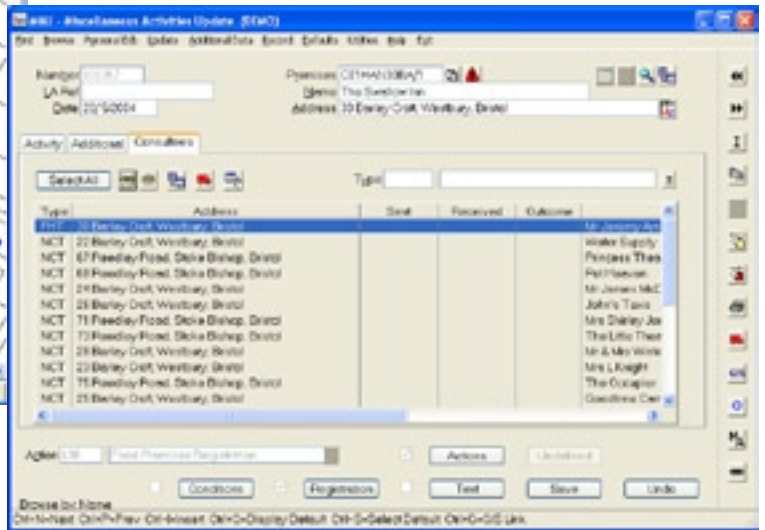

Consultees

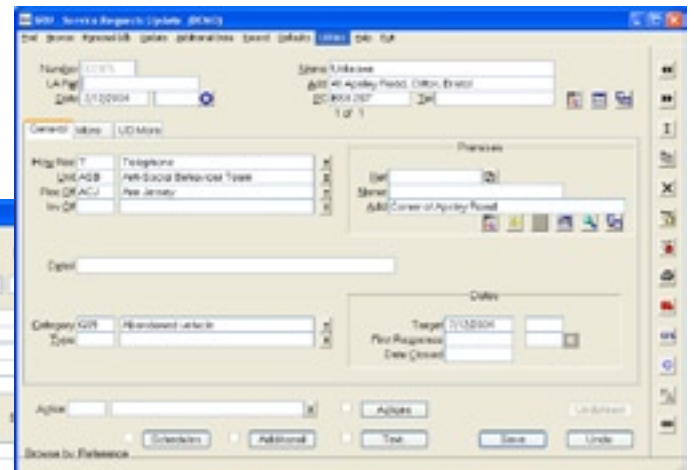
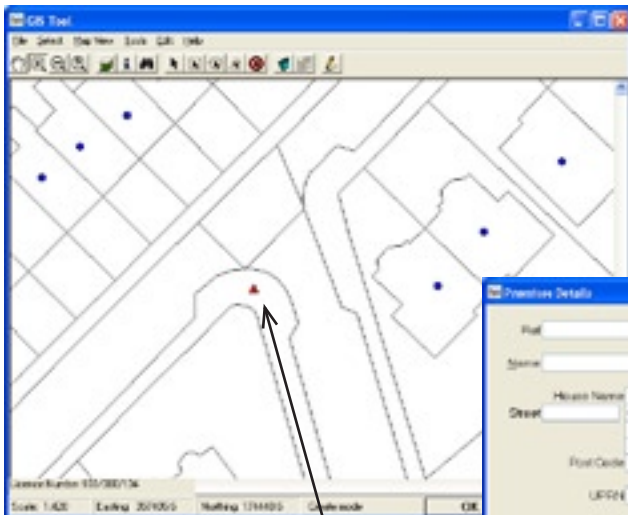


The example here shows properties within a specified area being selected as consultees. Address details are then pulled back into APP and a consultee record created.
